- **Format:** PPT or PDF containing 8-10 slides. Online presenters must keep their video/camera **ON** throughout their slot.

● **Medium of Paper:** Research papers are welcome in **Any Language** (Hindi, English, Sanskrit, Thai, Regional & Global Languages).

● **Page Limit:** The complete research paper must be within a **maximum of 06 pages** (including abstract, tables and references).

● **Mandatory File Formats:** Authors must submit **Both MS Word (.doc/.docx) and PDF files**. Submission of the **MS Word file is strictly mandatory**. Papers submitted without a Word file will **NOT** be accepted under any circumstances.

● **Font, Formatting & Margin Specs:**

I. Page Margin: A uniform margin of 1 inch (2.54 cm) on all four sides of the page.

II. English: Times New Roman, Font Size: 12, Line Spacing: 1.5

III. Hindi/Sanskrit: Kruti Dev 10, Font Size: 14, Line Spacing: 1.5

Mangal, Font Size: 12, Line Spacing: 1.5

IV. Other Languages: Standard Unicode Fonts, Font Size: 12-14, Line Spacing: 1.5

● **Publication Policy & Format (Digital/PDF Mode Only):**
